Selection results for learners' participation to the course on "Welfare Assessment and Best Practices in Cattle Farming in the European Union" that will be held in Santarem (Portugal) from 30 January to 3 February 2023 - Santarem (Portugal) in the frame of the KA220-VET - Cooperation partnerships in vocational education and training 2021-1-TR01-KA220-VET-000025255 - Dissemination of animal welfare practices in farmed ruminants.

Candidates have been evaluated following a merit-based selection process operated by an *ad-hoc* Committee, based on the following selection criteria (max score = 30):

- **For students** enrolled in master's and single-cycle Master's degree programmes, the academic transcript of records, and especially the number of credits and the grades obtained for exams specifically related to animal husbandry and animal welfare (as shown in the academic transcript of records reporting the grade for each passed exam) will be considered as a preferential attribute: max score = 10;
- **For all other applications (excluding students)**, knowledge of animal husbandry and animal welfare, as shown in the *Curriculum Vitae*): max score = 10;
- **For all applicants:** Level of English proficiency: max score = 5;
- **For all applicants:** Other documented relevant experiences: max score = 5;
- **For all applicants:** Strength of the motivations expressed in the motivation letter; max score = 10.
